

DUMPSTER USE

CONTACT THE SRA TREASURER TO BECOME A DUMPSTER USER.

1. The dumpsters are emptied once a week on **THURSDAY** (AS OF 3/2/06) afternoon, except when there has been a holiday in the previous week, in which event it will be emptied on FRIDAY afternoon.
2. Please collapse all cardboard boxes to save room. At the time of this posting, we have 28 residents signed up and paying for the dumpsters. We do not want to go to a third dumpster as the cost will go up for all users.
3. Please empty any cardboard boxes not full of trash and collapse them. See #2 above.
4. **DO NOT** place large items in the dumpsters such as mattress, bed box springs, hot water heaters, large furniture pieces, 55 gallon barrels, doors, etcetera. These items go to the Jeffco Sanitary Landfill on Hwy. 93 north of Golden.
5. **DO NOT** place hazardous materials such as liquid paint (empty open paint cans with dried paint are OK), car batteries, household chemicals, gas tanks, propane tanks, ammunition or other such items in the dumpsters. Jefferson County maintains a Hazardous Material site at 151 South Runney Road available at a very low cost for all Jeffco Residents. The telephone number is (303) 316-6262 for information and appointments.
6. **DO NOT** place brush, trees, slash, etcetera, in the dumpsters. Jefferson County has a site at 151 Runney Road for such items and no appointment is needed, but check before going to insure it is open. See #5 above. (The 1-970-454-3492 is a number for info on slash and brush disposal.) Another possibility is the Sampson Community Club June Roll-off/Spruce Up.
7. Try to place items into the dumpsters so it will conserve as much space as possible and will allow as much trash as possible to fit in the space.
8. Construction material should only be placed in the dumpsters the morning before scheduled emptying and only in reasonable amounts after reducing to small sizes, i.e. cut boards to 4', dry wall to 2' by 2', etcetera.
